### **Additional information on the fund's current situation: (optional)**

The production fund was cut down in 2008, because the biggest financier of POEM was to re-structure the industry development organizations in the region. This work was supposed to be carried out during 2008-2009; however it was not until February 2011 that the new department started. During this time POEM has not been able to invest or award any production support.

From 2009-2011 POEM has given 270 000 Euros in company development support, but this money is not possible to use for production. It can only be used for development, promotion, distribution, training etc.

POEM has also supported professional training and education through FilmArc and Film Commission projects in the region.
