### **Additional information on the fund's current situation: (optional)**

It has been decided by the Rotterdam city council to close down Rotterdam Media Fund.

Pending action and treatment by the Rotterdam municipality and city council this spring, the RMF management is severely hindered in carrying out its primary mission with the promotion, development and construction of media productions in the Rotterdam region.

As soon as more information concerning the future operation of RMF is available, the board of RMF will announce deadlines for 2011. RMF will in 2011 continue with the Lang Rotterdam Program (1<sup>st</sup> feature film/€ 200.000 budget). The Rotterdam Shorts Program will not continue in its current form in 2011.
