<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Created in 1991 to develop the film industry in the region, the fund is managed by CRRAV and provides financial supports for writing, development and production.</li> <li>• CRRAV is considered to be a non-executive minority producer.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Only production companies can apply.</li> <li>• The documentary project must appeal to a broadcaster certified by the CNC and/or a European one.</li> <li>• 20 % of the budget must be confirmed.</li> <li>• The film must be produced within 2 years.</li> <li>• CRRAV has set up a regional involvement points table to ensure the involvement of the production companies in the region.</li> <li>• This regional involvement points table allows CRRAV to determine if a project is eligible or not to the film fund.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Support from CRRAV ranges from €40.000 for a documentary film to €60.000 for a documentary series.</li> <li>• The producer and director commit themselves to producing the film within 2 years.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Foreign companies need to have a co-production agreement with co-producers resident in the region.</li> <li>• The shooting can take place outside the region.</li> <li>• A broadcaster is required.</li> <li>• Minority projects can be submitted.</li> <li>• A minimum budget must be secured before applying.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• CRRAV acts as a co-producer, demanding part of the rights and royalties to films.</li> <li>• In addition to its financial support, CRRAV has also decided to divide in half its part of the royalties in a documentary project.</li> </ul>
